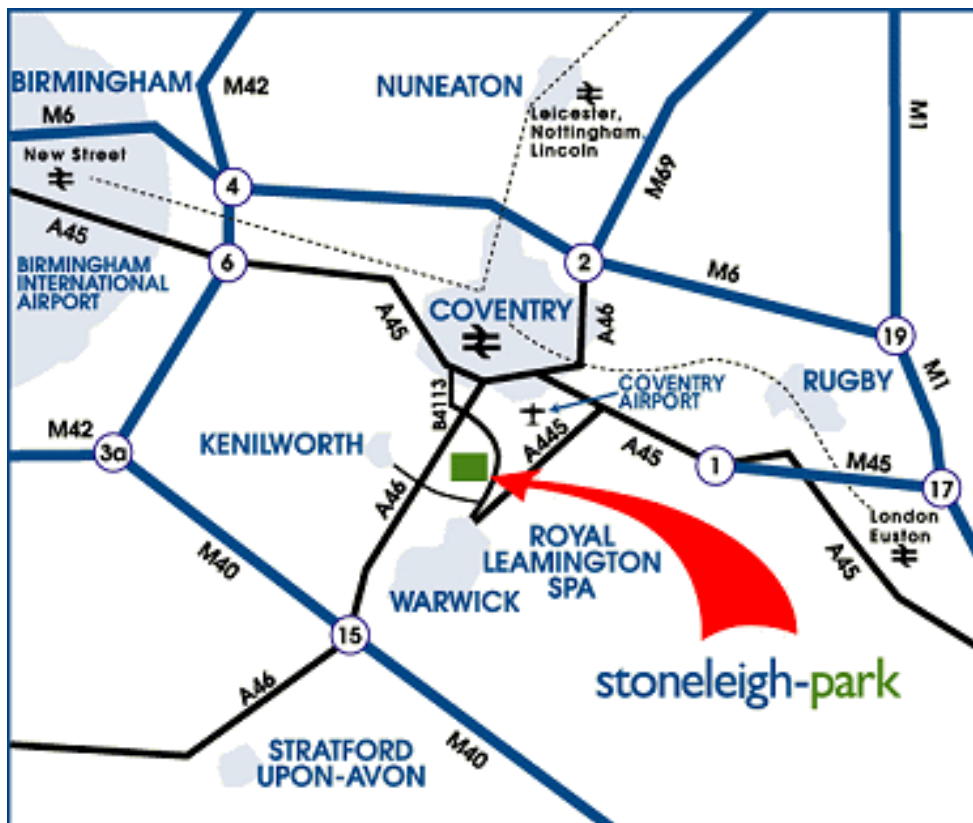


DIRECTIONS TO STONELEIGH PARK CV8 2LZ

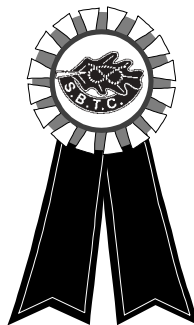

YOUR JUDGES FOR THE SHOW

NORMAN BERRY (RENDORN)

Norman bought his first Stafford at the latter end of 1960. Within months he joined his local club, The North West SBTC. After many years of committee work, including ten years as Chairman, he is now an Honorary Life Vice Member. Attending his first show, the NWSBTC Limit Show, he soon found himself hooked on dog showing, which is his greatest interest up to this present time.

In 1955, after a five year partnership with the breeder of his first puppy, he embarked on his own breeding programme, thus registering the "Rendorn" affix. During this time he bred a number of litters with a measure of success. This latest assignment will be his twenty sixth Championship Show appointment, he has also judged in various countries since his first overseas appointment in 1983. After resisting the urge to breed or show for quite a number of years, but still maintaining a great interest by attending many shows throughout the UK exhibitors can (with no axes to grind) be assured of a fair and forthright unbiased assessment.

JAMES BYRNES (LACKYLE)

Our bitch judges today is Mr James Byrnes from Ireland. This will be his second time awarding CCs in England. His first appointment was at Border Union in 2008. In Ireland Jim is a well established breeder, exhibitor and judge and he is qualified to judge all Terriers in Group 3, Gundogs in Group 7 & 8 and is also a Best in Show judge under IKC rules. He has also judged in Finland, Sweden, Australia, New Zealand and South Africa.

He is currently campaigning both in Ireland and England; Ir Ch Lackyle Diabhal Dearbhchlo (2 CCs & 4 RCCs), Lackyle Realta Eiri (5 Green Stars won in Ireland & Stud Book no in UK), Aust/Ir Ch Belleden Fleur De Rouge, (1 CC in UK to date), Other dogs of note from this kennel include; Ir Ch Wyrefare Elegant lady, Ir Ch Sparstaff premier Passion, Ch/Ir/Int Ch Lackyle Ceal Ma Olc & Ch/Ir /Int Ch Lackyle Diabhal Og. James thinks it is a great hour to have been asked to judge the SBTC Championship Show and I know he will give an honest and unbiased opinion.

DEFINITION OF CLASSES

1. In the following definitions a Challenge Certificate includes any Show award that counts towards the title of Champion under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club.
2. Wins at Championship Shows in Breed classes where Challenge Certificates are not on offer shall be counted as wins at Open Shows.
3. In the case of a dog owned in partnership and entered in Members' classes or competing for Members' Specials each partner must at the time of entry be a member of the Society.
4. In estimating the number of awards won all wins up to & including the seventh day before the date of closing of entries shall be counted when entering for any class ie. 23rd October 2010.
5. Wins in Variety classes do not count for entry in Breed classes but when entering for Variety classes, wins in both Breed and Variety classes must be counted. A First prize does not include a Special prize of whatever value.
6. If an exhibitor reports before judging of a class or classes that a dog has been entered which is ineligible, the exhibitor may choose one of the following options:-
 1. Withdrawal - the dog may be withdrawn from competition subject to the conditions of Regulations 9(j) & 20.
 2. Transfer - a) If a dog is ineligible for a class or classes as regards its breed, colour, sex, weight or height the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the equivalent class or classes for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and, in the event of their being no equivalent class, Minor Puppy & Puppy excepted to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
b) For an exhibit entered incorrectly in a Minor Puppy class, Puppy class or Junior class, which is over age but under 12 calendar months or 18 calendar months of age or 24 calendar months of age respectively, the Show Secretary shall transfer the exhibit to the Puppy class, Junior class or Yearling class respectively for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height and in the event of there being no Puppy, Junior or Yearling class to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
c) For any reason other than above, the Show Secretary shall transfer it to the Open class for the correct breed, colour, sex, weight or height.
7. If an exhibit arrives late & misses a class, even if it is the only class in which the dog is entered, the dog may NOT be transferred to any other class.

MINOR PUPPY: For dogs of six and not exceeding nine calendar months of age on first the day of the Show.

PUPPY: For dogs of six and not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

JUNIOR: For dogs of six and not exceeding eighteen calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

YEARLING: For dogs of twelve and not exceeding twenty four calendar months of age on the first day of the Show.

MAIDEN: For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or a First prize at an Open or Championship Show (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Puppy & Special Minor Puppy excepted) whether restricted or not.

NOVICE: For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or three or more First prizes at Open or Championship Shows (Minor Puppy, Special Minor Puppy, Special Puppy & Special Puppy Classes excepted) whether restricted or not.

POST GRADUATE: For dogs which have not won a Challenge Certificate or five or more First prizes at Championship Shows in Post Graduate, Minor Limit, Mid Limit, Limit and Open classes, whether restricted or not.

LIMIT: For dogs which have not become show Champions under the Kennel Club Regulations or under the rules of any governing body recognised by the Kennel Club or won 7 or more First Prizes in all at Championship Shows in Limit or Open Classes confined to the Breed, whether restricted or not at Shows where Challenge Certificates were offered for the breed.

OPEN: For all dogs of the Breed for which the class is provided and eligible for entry at this Show.

VETERAN: For dogs of not less than seven years of age on the first day the day of the Show.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. OPENING OF SHOW: The Show will open at 8.00 am
2. ARRIVAL OF DOGS: Dogs will be received at any time but it is the exhibitors responsibility to ensure that exhibits are available for judging when required.
3. JUDGING TIME: Judging will commence at 9.00am in both rings.
4. REMOVAL OF DOGS: Exhibits may be removed from the Show after their judging has been completed. The Show will close half an hour after all judging has been completed.
5. COOKING STOVES: The use of cooking stoves is forbidden except as authorised by the Show Management.
6. FEES: £12.00 per dog for the first class. All subsequent classes FREE with same dog.
7. PRIZE MONEY: Will not be paid at this Show.
8. REFUSAL OF ENTRIES: The Committee reserves to itself the right to refuse entries or advertisements.
9. PUPPIES: Puppies under six calendar months of age on the first day of the Show are not eligible for exhibition.
10. MATING OF BITCHES: The mating of bitches within the precincts of the Show is forbidden.
11. BEST PUPPY IN SHOW: Where a Best Puppy in Show is scheduled the Best Puppy in Show is a puppy which has competed & is unbeaten by any other puppy exhibited at the same Show. A puppy is a dog of six & not exceeding twelve calendar months of age on the first day of the Show. Where the Best in Show is a puppy it will automatically be Best Puppy in Show. Similarly, if the Reserve Best in Show is a puppy which has only been beaten by an adult dog it will also automatically be Best Puppy in Show. Consequently, selection of Best Puppy in Show must follow the selection of Best in Show. Best Puppy in Show must be selected from puppies which have been judged and which are unbeaten by any other puppy.
WITHDRAWAL FROM COMPETITION: Puppies which become eligible for Best Puppy in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition, other than Breed Classes, prior to the competition for Best Puppy in Show in order to remain unbeaten. A puppy beaten in competition for Best Puppy in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competitions for which it was previously eligible. The dog declared Best Puppy in Show, however, must not compete in any subsequent competition.
PROVISO: For the Purpose of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace & Team or a Special Award confined to one breed will not be considered to be a beaten dog.
12. BEST IN SHOW: The dog declared Best in Show is a dog which has competed & is unbeaten by any other dog exhibited at the same Show. Best in Show must be selected from the exhibits declared Best of Sex providing they are unbeaten winning dogs. Reserve Best in Show must be selected from the Best Opposite Sex and the Reserve Best of Sex to the exhibit declared Best in Show. The dogs declared Best in Show and Reserve Best in Show must not compete in any subsequent competition
WITHDRAWAL FROM COMPETITION: Dogs which become eligible for Best in Show may be withdrawn from all other competition other than Breed classes prior to the competition for Best in Show as appropriate in order to remain unbeaten. A dog beaten in competition for Best in Show may subsequently be exhibited in all competition for which it was previously eligible. The dogs declared Best in Show & Reserve Best in Show, however, must not compete in any subsequent competition.
PROVISO: For the Purpose of this Regulation, dogs beaten in competition for Stud Dog, Brood Bitch, Progeny, Brace & Team or a Special Award confined to one breed, will not be considered to be beaten dogs.
13. Exhibits will not be admitted to Best in Show competition after a period of 10 minutes has elapsed since the announcement that exhibits are required for judging, unless they have been unavoidably delayed by previous judging not being completed on time, and then only with the special permission of the Show Management.
14. REGULATIONS: No modifications will be made to this schedule except by permission of the General Committee of the Kennel Club, which will be followed by advertisement in the canine press wherever possible.
15. PREPARATION FOR EXHIBITION: All exhibitors must be familiar with Kennel Club Regulation F Annex B - Regulations for the Preparation of Dogs for Exhibition. A special place will be provided for the cleaning & preparation of exhibits & no other place within the precincts of the Show must be used for such purpose

RULES & REGULATIONS CONTD..

16. OVERSEAS EXHIBITS: All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to Compete number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
17. Your dog is vulnerable and at risk during hot weather and the Kennel Club offers the following guidance to help guide you through the do's and don'ts travelling to and whilst at KC licensed events.
 - 1) When travelling to a show please take a moment to consider whether the route to the show is on a busy holiday route, and leave earlier to avoid increased time in traffic jams.
 - 2) If your vehicle is not air-conditioned seriously consider whether travelling to the show is a good idea at all.
 - 3) The vehicle should be as fully ventilated as possible, and plenty of stops should be taken, with lots of water available to drink.
 - 4) Ensure your dog is not sitting in full sunlight. There should be plenty of free flowing air around the dog.
 - 5) When at the show, never leave your dog in the vehicle.
 - 6) Keep the dog in the shade - take your own shade for example a large umbrella and always have plenty of water available to drink so your dog stays well hydrated.
 - 7) Avoid your dog taking part in unnecessary exertion, or from standing in exposed sunlight for extended lengths of time. Remember, if you feel hot your dog is very likely to feel much hotter and dehydrated, and this could lead to dire results. Please look after your dog's welfare.

WARNING: IF YOUR DOG IS FOUND TO BE AT RISK FORCIBLE ENTRY TO YOUR VEHICLE MAY BE NECESSARY WITHOUT LIABILITY FOR ANY DAMAGE CAUSED.

Anyone whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met, and should not put a dog's health and welfare at risk by any action, default, omission or otherwise. Breach of Kennel Club Regulations in this respect may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
18. DOG FOULING: Any owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog is required to remove as soon as possible any fouling caused by their dog/s at any Kennel Club Licensed Show within the licensed venue & within the environs of the event including car & caravan parks & approaches.
19. ABIDE BY KC RULES: Every exhibitor making an entry at this Show shall be deemed to have agreed to abide by the Kennel Club Rules & Regulations and by these Regulations and it is on this understanding only that entries are received.
20. REPLACEMENT OF JUDGES: Should the judge be prevented from fulfilling his/her engagement the Committee reserves the right of appointing another judge (subject to the approval of the Kennel Club) to fulfil the duty. In which case exhibitors are at liberty to withdraw from competition, but no entry fees can be returned.
21. EXHIBITS ONLY: No animal other than a dog duly entered at the show will be admitted within the precincts of the Show.
22. DOGS IN CARS: Owners leaving dogs unattended in cars on hot days may be reported to the Kennel Club (KC Rule 42)
23. RESPONSIBILITY: It should be distinctly understood by exhibitors and spectators at the Show that the Committee will not be responsible for the entire or partial loss or detention of or damage to dogs or any other property whether arising from accident or any other cause whatsoever or from any act or omission of themselves or their officers, servants, agents or others. Exhibitors and spectators will be held responsible for any damage to property or equipment within the show environs caused by their children or children in their care. It is on this understanding that entries are accepted.
24. REGULATIONS F. F9 EXHIBITION OF DOGS:
 - a) No person shall carry out punitive correction or harsh handling of a dog at any time whilst at the licensed venue including its environs, car park and caravan parks and approaches.
 - b) The owner, exhibitor, handler or other person in charge of a dog at Kennel Club events must at all times ensure that the dog is kept under proper control whilst at the licensed venue, including its environs, car & caravan parks & approaches.
25. F12 FRAUDULENT OR DISCREDITABLE CONDUCT AT SHOWS: The Secretary of a Show must immediately report in writing to the Secretary of the Kennel Club.

Kennel Club Breeders' Competition 2010

The Breeders' Competition offers the following Awards:

Best Breeder in Breed
Best Breeder in AVNSC Classes
Best Breeder in Group 1st, 2nd, 3rd and 4th.
Grand Final at DFS Crufts 2011

The following requirements apply to entries for these awards:

1. Breeders wishing to enter the competition should first purchase a Breeders Competition Record Book from the Kennel Club or from the show secretary.
2. The Breeder enters for the award in his/her name and is responsible for arranging which exhibits form their breeder group, or team
3. The Breeder must complete the Record Book accurately with all necessary details before presenting it to the show organisers.
4. The Breeder is responsible for obtaining the necessary authority to compete from the show organisers (or designated official such as the Ring Steward) to compete for the award.
5. The Breeder's team must comprise four exhibits of the same breed, all of which must be entered in a class at the show.
6. A Breeder may enter more than one team per show.
7. All dogs must have the same registered breeder.
8. The 'beaten dog' rule will NOT apply.
9. Best Breeder in Breed and Best Breeder in AVNSC Classes goes through to a Best Breeder in Group award.
10. Breeders acquire points in competition over a calendar year as follows:

Breed win 1 point	Win in AVNSC Classes 1 point	Fourth in Group 1 point
Third in Group 2 points	Second in Group 3 points	First in Group 4 points

The thirty Breeders who have amassed the highest number of points over a calendar year will qualify for the DFS Crufts Final in the following year. At the end of the competition year in question, Breeders should forward their record books to the Canine Activities Department at the Kennel Club which will advise whether they have qualified for the DFS Crufts Final.

REGULATIONS FOR THE PREPARATION OF DOG FOR EXHIBITIONS F (B)

1. These regulations must be observed when a dog is prepared for exhibition and/or exhibited at any Kennel Club Licensed event. Objections may be referred to the General Committee for disciplinary action under these show regulations and/or for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rule A42. (a) A dog found to have been exhibited in breach of these regulations will automatically be disqualified from exhibition at the show and from any award gained there. (b) Unless the exhibitor provides a satisfactory explanation for the dog being exhibited in breach of these regulations, he/she may be subject to further penalties of either a fine or as listed under rule A42.
2. (a) No substance which alters the natural colour, texture or body of the coat may be present in the dog's coat for any purpose at any time during the show. No substance which alters the natural colour of any external part of the dog may be present on the dog for any purpose at any time during the show. (b) Any other substance (other than water) which may be used in the preparation of a dog for exhibition must not be allowed to remain in the coat or on any other part of the dog at the time of exhibition.
3. No act or operation which alters the natural conformation of a dog or any part thereof may be performed except:
(a) Operations certified to the satisfaction of the General Committee. (b) The removal of dewclaws of any breed (c) Operations to prevent breeding provided such operations are notified to the Kennel Club before neutered dogs are shown. Nor must anything be done calculated to in the opinion of the General Committee to deceive.
4. The General Committee without previous notice may order an examination of any dog or dogs at any Show. Any examination thus ordered will be made by a person having executive authority who shall have a written directive from the Kennel Club in their possession. Samples may be taken for further examination & analysis.
5. An individual has the right to lodge an objection to a dog only if he/she is the owner or handler of a dog competing in the same breed or class. An objection may, however, be lodged by any official of the Show or by anyone so deputed by the Kennel Club. It will be the responsibility of the individual who lodges the objection or the official (as appropriate), to substantiate the grounds for the objection. The Kennel Club will substantiate the grounds for an objection made on its behalf.
6. Any objection by an individual related to an infringement of these regulations must be made in writing to the Show Secretary at his/her office before the close of the Show & the individual must produce evidence of identity at the time of lodging the complaint.
